

WALT: begin to punctuate sentences using an exclamation mark


Perfect Punctuation

The Full Stop



- Most sentences end with a full stop.
- The sentence after a full stop always starts with a capital letter.

Tilly was a lovely dog. Every morning Tilly and her owner went for a walk.

Perfect Punctuation

The Exclamation Mark



- An exclamation mark ends a sentence that shows a strong feeling, like surprise or anger. They can also show that someone is raising their voice or shouting.
- Exclamation marks are often used in speech.
- The sentence after an exclamation mark always starts with a capital letter.

Get out! You are not allowed to go in that cupboard!




Activity


Find your colour group, read through the relevant story and see how many exclamation marks you can spot.
