New Learning

WALT: use the conjunctions 'and' 'or' 'but'

WALT: use subordinating conjunctions 'because' 'when'
'if' 'that'

Sentences contain a verb.

A complex sentences has extra detail. To get the extra detail we use a subordinate clause. This joins the sentences together using 'when' 'if' 'because' 'that'

e.g.

You can watch T.V. **if** you finish your homework. (in the event of)



Because (for the reason that)

They stopped building the house **because** it was raining too hard.



When (at that time)

I woke up **when** my dog was barking.



That

She went to the dance class **that** my best friend went too.
