New Learning

WALT: add a suffix to the root word

Today we are going to look at the 'est'

suffix

We can add the 'est' suffix to compare one person, action, thing or state to **all others** in the same group.

e.g. quietest

The word 'quietest' is written in a cursive font. The letters 'quiet' are in red, and the letters 'est' are in blue. A red arrow points from the text 'quiet' below to the 'quiet' part of the word above. A blue arrow points from the text '-est' below to the 'est' part of the word above.

'quiet' is the original adjective.

'-est' is the suffix.


It is comparing **more than two things** only.


E.g. Aisha is the quietest in the class.
