

## New Learning

WALT: add a suffix to the root word

(Think, Pair, Share)

**What is a suffix?**

A suffix is an ending to a root word

Today we are focusing on the suffix  
'er'

We can use the suffix 'er' to adjectives to compare two objects or people.

e.g. brighter

'bright' is the original  
adjective/root word.

'-er' is the suffix.



It is comparing **two things** only.

E.g. Sam's torch is brighter than John's torch.

I have a long pencil. Can you find a longer pencil?



I have a **small** book. Can you find a **smaller** book?
